This resource will help schools to plan, implement, and evaluate a sequential aquatic programme that meets the needs of their students.

The Integrated Aquatic Programme (IAP) provides teachers with an extensive overview of aquatic resources and sequential pathways for teaching and learning for years 0–8. It makes links to supporting resources, most of which are downloadable, and to aquatic agencies. The resources contain classroom-based activities that develop thinking and practical skills, and In at the Deep End has an ICT component.

The teacher's guide section of the IAP contains three competency models that show possible:

- skill progressions to develop water confidence, swimming, and water safety skills;
- knowledge progressions;
- attitudes and values required for safe participation.

The needs-analysis section helps to guide teachers with their planning as it identifies the needs of the students, staff, and community.
