2008 Secondary Schools Arts Coordinators Project

For the past seven years all state and integrated schools with secondary students have been able to apply to participate in the Secondary Schools Arts Coordinators project. The project is designed to promote learning in the Arts by seeking to support access to enriching arts experiences that may foster student learning and extend their knowledge, skills and achievement in the Arts. These enriching learning opportunities can include experiences within schools and the wider community environment – including gallery visits, artists visits, artists in residence, performances and theatre shows, skills-based workshops/demonstrations with artists/performers/mentors and arts competitions.

Schools may also use the funding to employ someone to coordinate these opportunities.
