

## 8 Create Similar Test

A user can create a test with the same setting as an existing test, but a different set of questions.

### 8.1 Create Similar Test Step 1: Select Test

The following information is given on this screen:

### Test Details

Test Name – user enters a name for the test. The user may want to use a similar naming convention to the one used when creating the *original* test, but then add a suffix to distinguish the copy from the original, e.g. a datestamp or a version number.

Description – a description of the purpose of the test.

### Original Test Details

The original test's name, subject, test type, description and test duration are listed here. The test generation process will use the same settings in the creation of the new test.

### Curriculum Level / Curriculum Strands

The original test's curriculum levels and curriculum strands settings are listed here. The test generation process will use the same slider settings in the creation of the new test.

### Delivery Method

The original test's delivery method details are listed here. The test generation process will use the same settings in the creation of the new test.

## 8.3 Create Similar Test Step 3: Test Creation

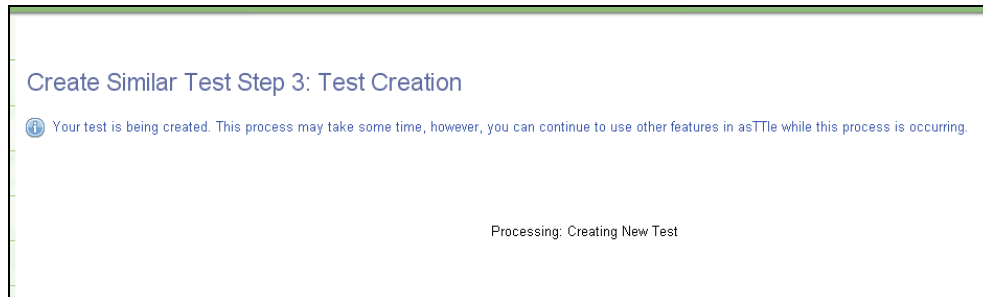


Figure 27. Create Similar Test Step 3
