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Student Instructions Sheet

This task is in two parts.

Imagine that you are on an exchange programme in France and are involved in planning for a party.

Part A involves planning for the party which will be this Saturday evening.

Part B is a letter all about the party which you write to a friend who could not be there.

Part A:

- Write an invitation for the party. You could include the following:
 - time, date, venue
 - purpose
 - what they have to bring

- Planning for the party: - a friend has offered to help you prepare something for the party, e.g. a salad. You need to write the recipe clearly so that he/she can follow it.
You could include the following:
 - the ingredients
 - method

Part B:

It is Sunday afternoon. You are writing a letter to a friend in France who could not make it to the party. You could include:

- who was there
- what you were wearing
- what the party was like
- what time it finished
